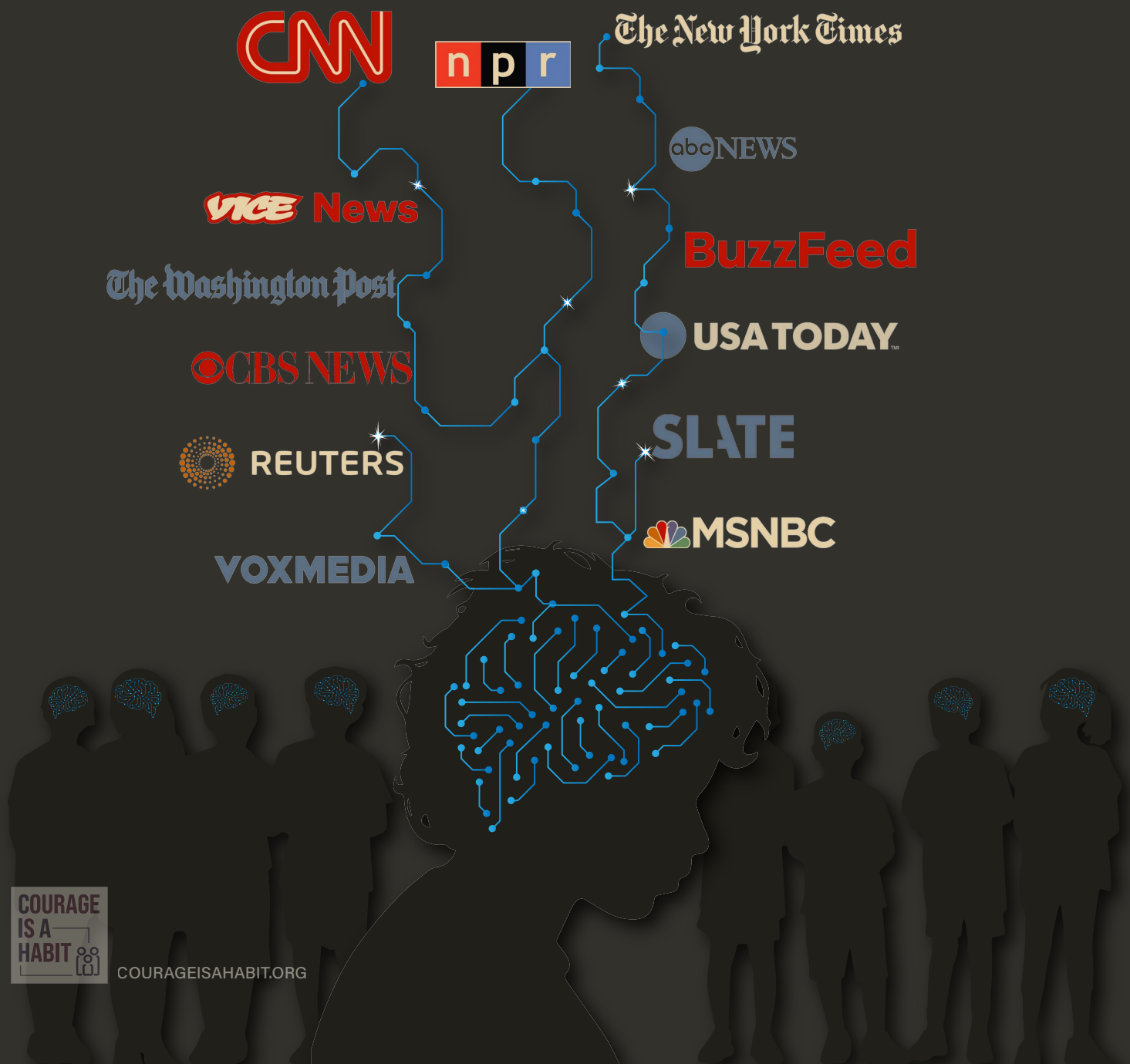

What is an NGO?

Non-Governmental Organizations (NGO) are nonprofit groups who are often funded by local, state, and federal government grants and contracts (taxpayers). NGOs work independent of government control (rules, regulations) to promote social and political change.

Why should parents care?

Unbeknownst to the majority of parents, K-12 public schools are partnering with NGOs, utilizing their services to advance progressive and radical ideologies. This clandestine partnership takes advantage of the "non-partisan" façade these NGOs present, all too often escaping parental notice.

What should parents do?

Contact your principal and formally request a comprehensive roster of all NGOs involved with the school, along with the specific details of the information used to influence your child's education and beliefs.

What is a public/private partnership?

A public-private partnership in education involves a taxpayer-funded public school contracting with a private NGO to provide lessons, training, and curriculum.

However, the school may use the NGO's proprietary status to withhold specific details from parents.

For example:

Corpus Christi ISD spent \$73,288.88 of US taxpayer dollars in September 2021 to purchase SEL curriculum from NGO 'Second Step,' but [denied parents access to the lesson plans](#) citing 'copyright protection.'



WHO IS THE NEWS LITERACY PROJECT (NLP)?

The [News Literacy Project](#) (NLP) is an NGO, based in Washington, D.C., that has partnered with major mainstream news outlets to provide resources for:

—● EDUCATORS —● STUDENTS —● GENERAL PUBLIC

They claim to be non-partisan yet all their supporting partners, board members, and correspondents only subscribe to progressive left-wing beliefs.

HOW DO THEY DEFINE "MEDIA LITERACY"?

Critical-thinking skills for analyzing and judging the reliability of news and information, differentiating among facts, opinions, and assertions in the media we consume, create and distribute.

WHAT THEY ACTUALLY MEAN BY "MEDIA LITERACY"?

Facts, opinions and assertions should only be obtained from mainstream media outlets and 3-letter government agencies.

WHAT IS NLP's MISSION?

NLP has devised a comprehensive four-year strategy aimed at integrating itself into the field of K-12 education. This plan involves leveraging the Mainstream Media (MSM) as a tool to impart the notion that they are the single source of "credible media" to students. Simultaneously, they are discrediting information and news sources (such as independent media and journalists) that do not conform to the narrative of the MSM. ***Their key mission is to make their brand of "media literacy" a high school graduation requirement in all 50 states.***

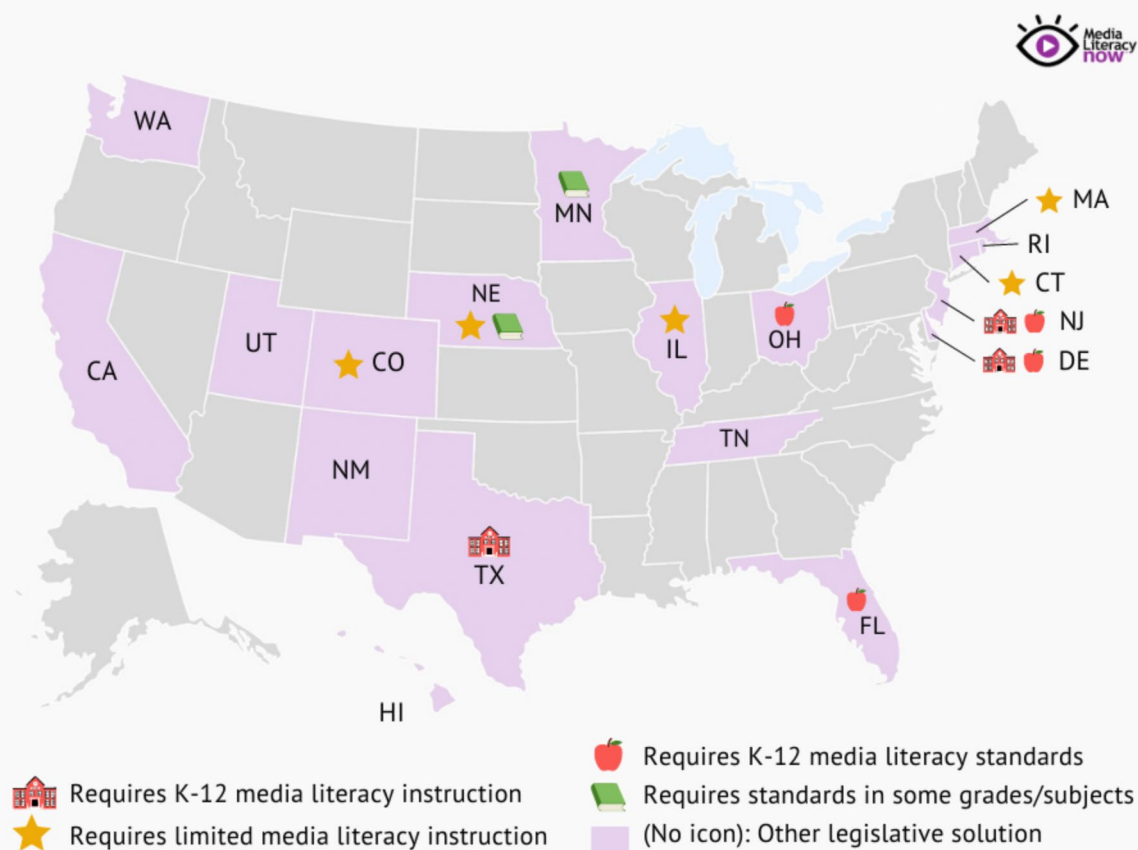
"MEDIA LITERACY" IN SCHOOLS

(This is not an exhaustive list)

States mandating some form of media literacy education prior to graduation: Illinois, Texas, New Jersey.

States currently providing funding for media literacy education: Colorado, New Mexico, Hawaii, California, Pennsylvania, Utah, Iowa, Florida, Ohio, Washington, Connecticut and Michigan.

States with statutes encouraging media literacy: California, Colorado, Connecticut, Florida, Hawaii, Massachusetts, New Mexico, Ohio, Rhode Island, Tennessee, Texas and Washington.



This map was last updated March 2023.

While your state may not be included in this map, it DOES NOT imply that your school district hasn't introduced some form of "media literacy" propaganda. It simply means it is not mandated yet. Maine isn't shown on this map, but their state department of education website uses NLP as a resource.

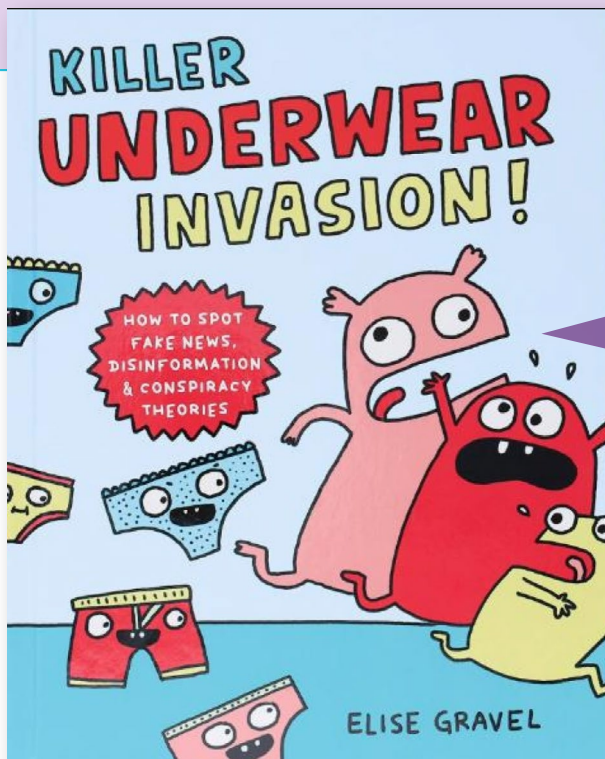

- Maine school libraries are stocking a children's graphic novel meant to **teach "news literacy"**...meant to **persuade children not to trust their families over the corporate news media.**
- The NLP and "Killer Underwear Invasion" are both aimed at **teaching kids to only trust information that comes from the largest corporate media brands.**
- "When a majority of experts and scientists agree on a topic, there's a good chance that they're right," the book states, presenting a statistic that **98 percent of scientists say climate change is real** as an example. *Ironically, the author does not cite a source for this statistic.*
- Began a four-year education plan in 2022...to **"collectively push back against misinformation** in all its forms," with a goal of **establishing new media literacy requirements for students** in states that do not yet have them.

NLP is partnered with a massive network MSM partners that provide lessons and training to public schools to teach "media literacy."

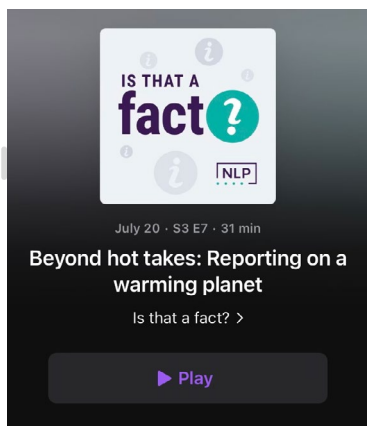

Politics has certainly influenced who has chosen to get vaccinated. According to the [Kaiser Family Foundation](#), "there continue to be differences in COVID-19 vaccination rates along partisan lines, a gap that has grown over time." The Kaiser study showed that almost 53 percent of people who live in counties that voted for Biden were fully vaccinated compared to nearly 40 percent of people in counties that went to Trump.

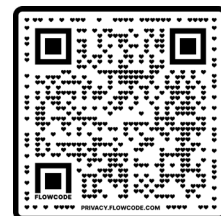
